“We the People” demand that the federal government acknowledge and act on their border responsibility by halting the construction and removing the illegal shipping containers. We also speak to the severing of critical wildlife corridors for the endangered jaguar and ocelot, as well as all our native wildlife that must move back and forth across the border to access food, water, and shelter to survive.

I witnessed with a few colleagues on November 20, 2022, contractors working at breakneck speed constructing the illegal container wall; bulldozing mature oak trees, depositing huge swaths of

excavated earth on standing trees and plants, grasslands, washes, and ephemeral stream beds, creating new roads, widening the Roosevelt easement border road, pummeling the native grasslands and plants with their track vehicles, creating new “staging areas” that heretofore were undisturbed forest and grassland areas, driving at unsafe excessive rates of speed along Forest Service roads endangering the lives of all those that are traveling in this region and intimidating Arizonans who want to enjoy their public lands as is their right by law, but are now threatened daily.

The rule of law must be followed and We the People will not be intimidated or dissuaded from enjoying our beautiful borderlands within the Coronado National Forest.

Make your Voice heard. Participate in the dialogue. Join us in this peaceful protest. Bring your signs, banners, songs and statements.
