What: DoJ Stipulation to the State of Arizona to Remove Container Wall

When: *December 22, 2022*

The United States Department of Justice and the State of Arizona have reached an agreement that the State must remove the illegally placed containers in both the Yuma Sector and the Coronado National Forest. The due date for completion of said removal AND remediation of the extensive damage in Yuma is 4 January 2023. The due date and plan for the Coronado National Forest sector is to be determined by 29 December 2022.

We the People demand full transparency of the plans for the removal and remediation. We call for there to be oversight and consultancy with organizations that possess the expertise for this important and critical work.

Without the persistence and dedication of the Border Wall Resistance volunteers, the damage done in the Coronado National Forest would have been significantly greater. Due to our efforts, only 3.6 miles of the planned 10 miles of wall were able to be completed. The residents of the State of Arizona will not have to pay twice for the 6.4 miles of uncompleted wall.

This legal agreement vindicates our claims that this wall was illegal, destructive and needed to be stopped immediately.
